

Lamesa Press-Reporter Wedding Form

Please submit ALL information on this form if at all possible. If additional space is required, please use full sheets of paper in an organized manner.

Please print or type all information, being especially careful that names and places are spelled correctly. Information must be submitted by NOON THURSDAY to be included in the Sunday paper. We will print a full-length wedding story kept under 40 column inches, at no charge, if the information is submitted in time to be published *within three weeks* after the date of the wedding. If your wedding write-up is longer than 40 column inches, we will call you and give you the option of having the editor edit the write-up or you pay to have the wedding run in full. Information submitted four-six weeks after the wedding will result in a condensed story, with most descriptive information omitted, unless you are willing to pay to have it run in its entirety. We will not print a wedding story later than six weeks after the wedding unless they are paid for.

PHOTOS: The *Press-Reporter* can use either color or black and white glossy photos. Photos should be submitted with the wedding information and can be retrieved after the story appears in the paper. Some photography studios will e-mail photos and that is also acceptable. E-mail address is lifestyles@pressreporter.com.
